Background

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must satisfy any one of the following:

- attended a music-related CCA
- has at least a Grade 3 in Theory/Practical in a musical instrument
- represented the school at a local/international competition, festival or performance (eg: SYF, SIBF, SNYO, National Day Parade, Mosaic Music Festival)
- participated in at least 2 performances to a live audience (e.g. school events/ public performance)
- has any other outstanding achievement in relevant areas

Shortlisting criteria

Applicant will be shortlisted if they meet any one of the eligibility criteria.

Selection criteria

In addition to the above-mentioned criteria, shortlisted applicants must attend an audition.

The teacher-in-charge will contact the applicant/parent/guardian with regard to the details of the audition.

Documents to submit

You must submit a photocopy of the following documents ALONG WITH your application form **by 4th August 2017**:

- Primary 5 end-of-year and Primary 6 mid-year examination result slips
- Record of Co-Curricular Activity, certificate of proficiency, community service record, certificate of achievements, etc.
- Registration number slip from the Ministry of Education (MOE) if you are studying in a non-MOE school
- Outcome letter for AEIS (for international students who are required to pass the test)

Please arrive about 20 minutes before the audition in order to complete the verification of documents. Present the above documents to the staff in the General Office. If you do not have the original document, please have the photocopy certified by the issuing school/organisation before sending in together with your application form.
