We are looking for applicants who exhibit all or some of the following qualities to join the school:

(1) Possess strong leadership qualities

Holds a leadership position in a uniformed group, CCA or in the primary school (e.g. prefect, class monitor, sports leader)

(2) Good fitness level

Has obtained at least a Silver Award in the Primary school NAPFA test

(3) Good character

Has obtained a Conduct Grade of at least 'Good' in Primary 5 and 6

Shortlisting criteria

All applicants who meet all the eligibility criteria will be shortlisted/

Selection criteria

All shortlisted applicants must go through an interview.

The teacher-in-charge will contact applicant/parent/guardian with regard to the interview details.

Documents to Submit

You must submit a photocopy of the following documents ALONG WITH your application form by 04th August 2017:

- Primary 5 Mid-Year and End-of-Year result slips and Primary 6 Mid-Year result slips
- Character Awards (e.g. Edusave Character Award (ECHA), School-based Character Award)
- Record of leadership responsibilities
- Record of Co-Curricular activities
- Record of NAPFA test results in P4 and P6

You are also encouraged to submit the following:

- Teacher's referral letter and/or testimonials
- Other relevant portfolio of achievements/awards
